Appointment or Change of Dissertation Committee

Dissertation Committee: The dissertation committee is composed of at least three, and no more than five, members. The committee chair must have an appointment in the student's program. All committees must have a majority of members from the student's home program. This includes the expertise of tenured, tenure track, research, teaching, practitioner and clinical faculty.

A USC faculty member from outside the student's home program is called an "outside member." For outside faculty the judgment of qualification to serve will be made by the dean of the school of the outside faculty member's primary appointment.

A faculty member from an institution other than USC is called an "external member." The CV of the external member must be attached to the Appointment of Committee form PDF and uploaded to Thesis Center. Outside and/or External members should be identified as such in the Appointment Type column below.

If the student is changing the committee chair, the signature of the previous chair is required here: For all changes of committee, please list the names of all committee members. Only the new member(s) and committee chair are required to sign.
